
Joshua – A Caring, Community-Minded Citizen

Jay has been part of Josh's team for over a year and has really become acquainted with his interests and unique personality. With both of them being eager to get out there, Jay started looking into possible community activities that Joshua might be interested in.

To Josh's delight, Jay found a neighbourhood church which also acts as a community hub by hosting many non-profit organizations during the week. One of the activities is an exercise group run by the VON. Joshua started volunteering as a greeter and directed people to the class. Over a few weeks, the organizers and participants got to know Josh and everyone wanted him to stay and join in the fun. Once he finishes greeting, Joshua now takes laps around the gym with the group and participates in some of the exercises. Each week, Josh increases his connections and his network. He is able to share his talents and receive friendship and connection in return.
